

ADULT READING LOG



Adults are encouraged to participate in our summer reading program. It's easy — just follow the guidelines on the reverse side to choose various types of books, and record the author and title of each book you read on the appropriate line. You may read the books in any order. Although we encourage you to check out books from us (it helps our circulation statistics), it is not necessary for all of the books to be from our library.

Everyone who completes the reading log will receive a prize in August. Also, for every line of the reading log you complete, you will receive an entry for our summer prize drawings. (Please ask for these when you turn in your log.)

Even if you don't completely finish the list, please turn in your log, so we know how many people participated. Also, for every line of the reading log you complete, you will receive an entry for our prize drawings. (Please ask for these when you turn in your log.)

Please consider signing up for our ARKS (Adults Reading Kids' Stuff) reading program as well. There are a lot of wonderful books for children and youth that you would enjoy. Read 25 books to be entered in the ARKS drawing.

The program runs from June 1 - Aug. 3, about 9 weeks.

Select a book that fits our showtime theme. Read it during the month of June and complete a “Read without Boundaries” form to be entered in a quarterly prize drawing.

How about trying a new author? Read a book by an author whose work you’ve never read before.

Open a book by a favorite author.

Why not try a different format (magazine, graphic novel, ebook, audiobook) or a different genre than you usually read.

Travel to new places through the pages of a book. Read a book with a travel theme during the month of July and complete a “Read Without Boundaries” form to be entered in a quarterly prize drawing.

Influence a young reader. Read a book to a child, or read a Juv or Young Adult book that you can recommend to a child or a teen.

Meander through the Mystery section to choose a book, or select a Large Print Mystery.

Explore the past. Read a nonfiction book of history, a biography of someone from the past, or a historical fiction novel.

NOTE: audio books and ebooks are acceptable if they meet all of the other criteria.
