- Designs must be the original work of the artist. Please, no copyrighted figures or characters.
- Bookmark designs must have a library-related theme: libraries, books, or reading.
(The 2020 National Library Week Theme is: “Find Your Place @ the Library” if that helps inspire ideas.)
- All designs must stay within the lines of the box below. (7 ½ x 2 ¼ inches, printed landscape)
- Entries become the property of the Carthage Public Library. We may copy the bookmarks for distribution and post them on our Website or Facebook page.
- Bookmarks will be judged on theme, creativity, originality, attractiveness, and neatness.
- There is a limit of one entry per person.
- All entries will be divided into age groups: children, youth, teens, and adults. Specific age divisions will be determined based on the number of entries received from each age. One winner will be chosen from each of the age categories.
- Each winning bookmark will be produced in limited quantities and distributed at the library during National Library Week, April 20-25. They will also be posted on the Library’s Facebook Page and website.
- Each winner will receive \$5.00 in “library cash” which may be used to pay for overdue fines, copies, or book sale items.
