Summer reading is for everyone from newborns to senior citizens! Come join the summer reading program. Participants have the option to log their reading on the app ReaderZone or on paper. We have an early literacy reading log for babies through those entering kindergarten. Readers between first and fourth grade will keep track of the number of minutes they read. Readers fifth grade and older will keep track of the titles of books they read over the summer. Adults also have the option to participate in SPARKS (Summer Program for Adults Reading Kids Stuff.)
