Fundraising for New Library Continues

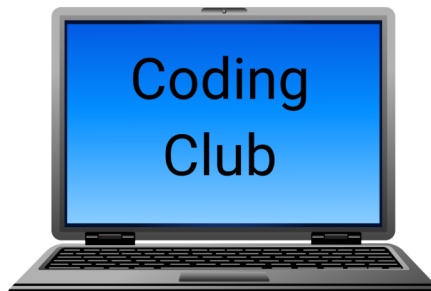
The Foundation has received a bronze level gift. The \$10,000 has been designated for use for furnishing the teen area of the new library.

Pre-School Storytime



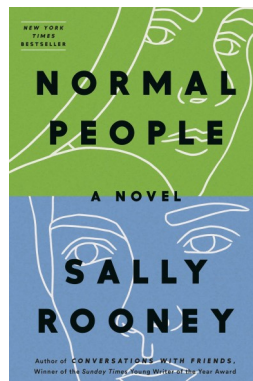
